**FOR A SAFE AND ENJOYABLE VISIT**

- Slow down
- Stay single file

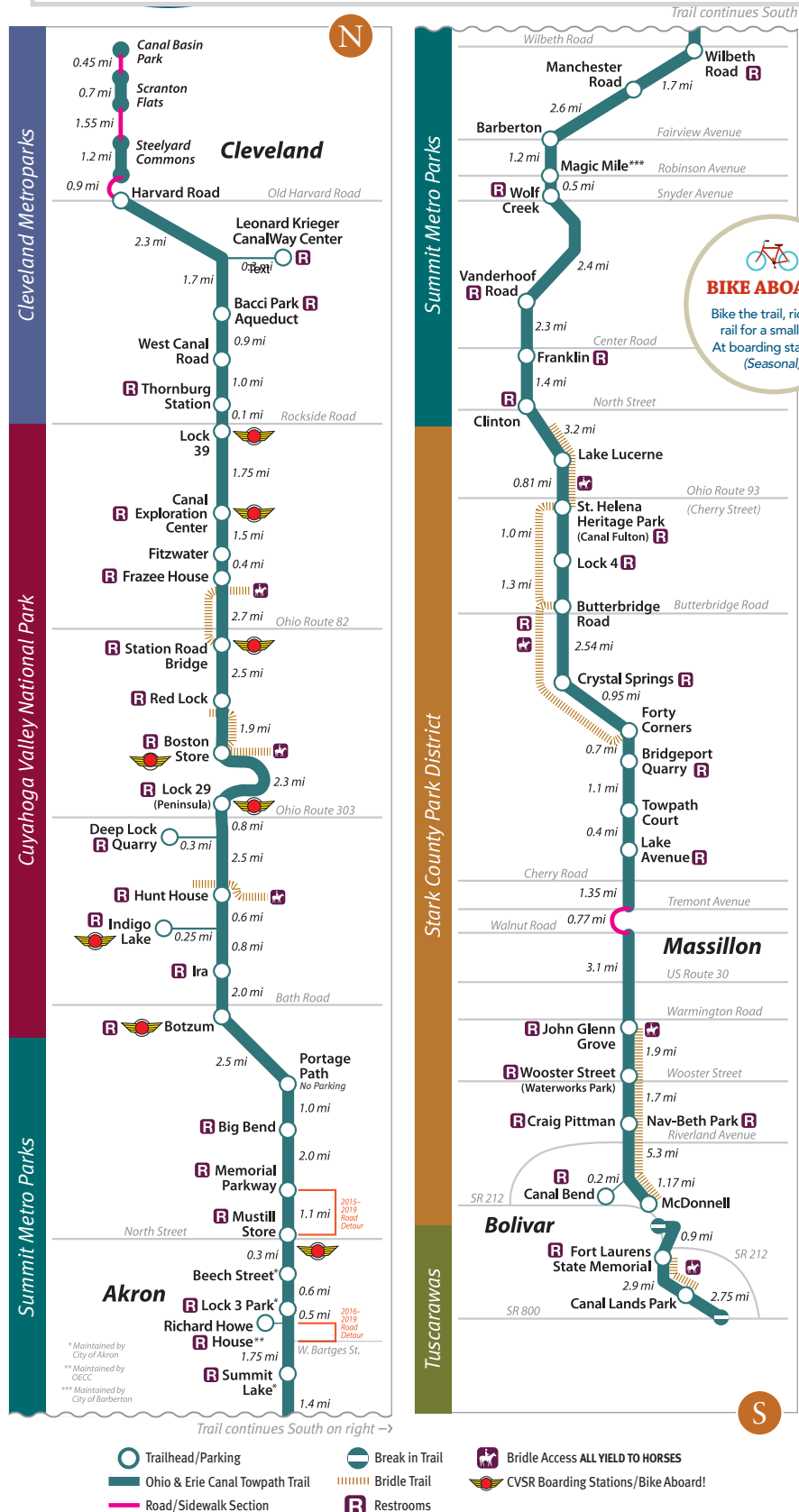

RIDE LEADERS who schedule a Towpath ride should list the Trailhead name in the "Starting Location" column and whether the ride goes north or south from there. In the "Class" column write TRAIL. Or TRAIL/NR, TRAIL/O, TRAIL/C etc if you want to be more specific about the type of trail ride you are leading. In the "Map #" column write 801. For TRAIL rides the ride leader determines the distance. It is suggested that you start the ride at a trailhead with a restroom. And it is suggested you choose your distance so that the turn-around point is at a trailhead. It is also suggested you provide the address for the trailhead at which you are starting the ride so that the Road Captain can provide it as a footnote in the ride schedule. Addresses are not necessary for trail rides starting at any of our established road ride starting locations. DESCRIPTION: Flat. Mostly packed limestone south of Clinton & mostly paved north of Clinton.
