

SCBC TOURS

A SCBC Tour is a multi-day event outside the local SCBC area, conducted by SCBC members, and conducted exclusively for SCBC members. The purpose of this direction is to provide formal guidance to those wishing to sponsor, organize and conduct such a tour. It also is meant to provide a means to promote SCBC touring.

To promote a yearly touring schedule, the President will call for a meeting open to all SCBC members at least yearly to discuss proposed tours and appoint individuals and committees to organize these tours.

Before a tour is finalized and advertised to the membership the following issues will be resolved:

1. Tours will be submitted to the Executive board for approval.
2. Tours must be planned and organized by SCBC members (no organized tours such as G.O.B.A. will be counted).
3. Tours must be submitted on a timely basis so that tentative participants can make appropriate plans. (A weekend tour to western PA might require only two months while a trip to Utah should be planned 4-6 months in advance)
4. Dates of the proposed tour will be defined.
5. Type of tour is outlined (sagged, self-contained, credit card, etc.).
6. Start and end points for the tour will be defined.
7. Daily start and end points will be defined along with mileages (highlights along the route should be mentioned).
8. Hotel/motel arrangements will be defined (location, phone numbers, rates, etc.).
9. Special mention should be made if number of riders is to be limited.
10. All tour details will be provided in the Spokin' Word two months prior to the month of the tour, i.e., May Spoken' Word for a tour in July.
11. Daily ride mileages will be provided to the Road Captain for inclusion in the monthly schedule.

In special cases, a tour may be proposed by a member outside the meeting held annually. These tours will be planned in accordance with the guidance in 1-11 above.
